The Book of Sirach suggests a practical
reason for acting with humility: humble
people are more likeable than the arrogant.
Even God “finds favor” with those who
humble themselves.

In Luke’s Gospel, Jesus provides real-world
suggestions for growing in humility and
teaches us *never to assume we are better
than others*. His words change our outward
behavior and expand our hearts and minds to
care about people we might have dismissed
before. This practical, almost “folksy”
wisdom about humility helps us behave
better in daily life and makes our lofty goal
of eternal life more accessible. Our reading
from Hebrews affirms that heaven is indeed

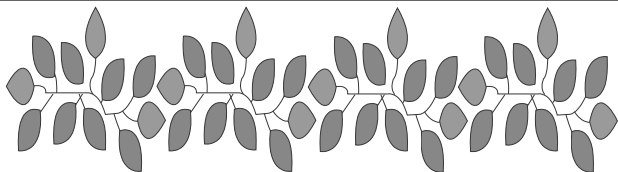

Perhaps you have been away from Confession for a long time, or are unsure how to go to Confession. Don't let that keep you away!

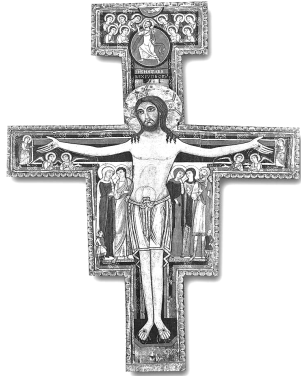
