SERVE THE LORD WITH JOY *Sluzmy Bogu z radoscia Servir al Señor con alegría*

"Why?" Sometimes toddlers can wear down their parents with that simple question. They are just inquisitive about their expanding environment and world. But such a successive question, why, can be a bit tedious. It has been my experience that as we grow older we ask the same question, why, with just larger ramifications. One of the beauties of the teachings of Jesus through the Church is that we receive the answer to many of those fundamental questions. The problem is that as we get older we are afraid to ask that wonderful question, why, out loud.

As we move further into the pastoral year I join my brother priests in wanting to help you find the answers to those innermost questions of why. Of course you are not seeking our response but rather the answers that come from the One who is the Way and the Truth and the Life. As Sunday School begins next week and with our Academy going full speed ahead, our students have an opportunity to ask those meaningful questions. But what about you? What do you want to ask? What do you wonder about?

This year the parish will offer several opportunities to allow individual to deepen their Catholic faith and to have their questions answered. Here are a few of them:

1) The end of the month our RCIA program will begin for adults in need of one or more of the sacraments of initiation. However, our program will be offered to anyone who wishes to learn more about their faith. RCIA in English will take place every Tuesday at 7:00pm in the Rectory and in Spanish on Sundays after the 9:30am Mass.

2) On September 24 at 3:00pm we will be holding our first youth event. These youth gatherings, which will take place once a month, will give us the opportunity to answer the youth's questions about Jesus and the Church.

3) I will begin to meet with those who serve as liturgical ministers (Lectors, Ministers of Holy Communion, Altar Servers). These meetings will not only give us the chance to go over the practicalities of serving in their ministries but also to give the opportunity for one to grow in the knowledge of their faith especially as it pertains to their role during Mass.

These three endeavors are precious because they are not classes to be taught but, rather, a discussion and conversation for those gathered to encounter Jesus and His teachings as they have lived on in the Church. I look forward to answering your questions and you helping to answer mine. **Fr. Kuroly**

DLACZEGO?

Czasem male dzieci moga zamezcac rodzicow tym prostym pytaniem. One sa po prostu ciekawe tego, co dzieje sie wokol nich i w swiecie. Ale takie nieustanne pytanie, *dlaczego*, moze byc nieco nuzace. Zauwazyłem, ze kiedy stajemy sie starsi, zadajemy to samo pytanie, *dlaczego*, tyle, ze dotyczy ono szerszego zakresu. Jedna z zalet nauczania Kosciola o Jezusie jest to, ze otrzymujemy odpowiedz na wiele fundamentalnych pytan. Problem w tym, ze kiedy jestesmy starsi, obawiamy sie zadawac to wspaniale pytanie *dlaczego* pelnym glosem. Zaczal sie wlasnie nowy rok pastoralny. Lacze sie z moimi braćmi kaplanami w trudzie znalezienia odpowiedzi na te najskrytsze pytania *dlaczego*. Oczywiscie Ty nie oczekujesz naszych odpowiedzi, ale raczej odpowiedzi pochodzacej od Tego Jednego, ktory jest Prawda i Zyciem. Nasza Szkola Niedzielną rozpoczyna sie w następnym tygodniu, i z nasza Akademia na pelnym biegu, nasi studenci maja mozliwosc zadawania tych znaczących pytan. A Ty? O co chcialbys zapytac? Czy cos Cie nurtuje, zastanawia?

W tym roku Parafia oferowac bedzie rozne mozliwosci indywidualnego poglebiana naszej wiary katolickiej, a takze znalezienia odpowiedzi na niektore pytania. Oto kilka informacji:

1) Pod koniec miesiaca rozpocznie sie nasz program RCIA (Obrzed chrzescijanskiego wtajemniczenia doroslych), ktorzy potrzebuja jednego lub kilku sakramentow inicjacji. Jednakze nasz program

oferowac bedziemy tym ktorzy zechca dowiedziec sie wiecej o ich wierze. Zajecia w jezyku angielskim odbywac sie beda w kazdy wtorek o 7 wieczorem w Rektoracie. W jezyku hiszpanskim zajecia beda w niedziele po Mszy Sw. o 9:30.

2) 24 wrzesnia o godz. 3 po poludniu odbędzie sie nasze pierwsze spotkanie z młodzieza. Takie spotkania, odbywajace sie raz w miesiacu, rowniez beda okazja do udzielenia mlodym ludziom odpowiedzi na nurtujace ich pytania o Jezusie i Kosciele.

3) Ja sam bede spotykal sie z osobami, ktore sluzą w rozny sposob podczas liturgii (Lektorzy, Ministranci, Szafarze Komunii Swietej). Te spotkania nie tylko pozwola nam na omowienie strony praktycznej danej posluzgi liturgicznej, ale takze stworza tym osobom mozliwosc poszerzenia ich wiedzy o wierze, szczegolnie w zakresie dotyczacym ich roli pelnionej podczas Mszy Swietej.

Te trzy przedsiwzięcia sa cenne, poniewaz nie sa to lekcje do nauczania sie, a raczej dyskusja, rozmowy z uczestnikami na temat spotkania sie z Jezusem i Jego naukami, ktore zyly i przetrwaly w Kosciele do naszych czasow. Mam nadzieje odpowiedziec na Wasze pytania i rowniez oczekuje, ze Wy pomożecie odpowiedziec na moje.

¿Por qué? A veces los niños pueden desgastar a sus padres con esa simple pregunta. Ellos son simplemente curiosos acerca de su entorno y mundial en expansión. Pero tal pregunta sucesiva, por eso, puede ser un poco tedioso. Ha sido mi experiencia que a medida que envejecemos nos preguntamos la misma pregunta, ¿por qué, con ramificaciones simplemente más grandes. Una de las ventajas de las enseñanzas de Jesús a través de la Iglesia es que recibimos la respuesta a muchas de esas preguntas fundamentales. El problema es que a medida que envejecemos tenemos miedo de pedir que maravillosa pregunta, ¿por qué, en voz alta.

A medida que avanzamos en el año pastoral me uno a mis hermanos sacerdotes en su deseo de ayudar a encontrar las respuestas a estas preguntas íntimas de por qué. Por supuesto no pretenden nuestra respuesta sino más bien las respuestas que vienen de Aquel que es el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida. Como escuela dominical comienza la próxima semana y con nuestra Academia avanzando a toda velocidad, nuestros estudiantes tienen la oportunidad de hacer esas preguntas significativas. ¿Pero qué hay de ti? ¿Qué quieres preguntar? ¿Qué te preguntas acerca?

Este año la parroquia ofrecerá varias oportunidades para permitir individuo a profundizar en su fe católica y tener respuestas a sus preguntas. Éstos son algunos de ellos:

1) El final del mes nuestro programa de RICA comenzará para adultos en necesidad de uno o más de los sacramentos de iniciación. Sin embargo, nuestro programa se ofrecerá a cualquier persona que desee aprender más sobre su fe. RCIA en Inglés se llevará a cabo todos los martes a las 7:00 pm en la Rectoría y en español los domingos después de la misa de 9:30 am.

2) El 24 de septiembre a las 3:00 pm vamos a celebrar nuestro primer evento juvenil. Estas reuniones de jóvenes, que se llevará a cabo una vez al mes, nos darán la oportunidad de responder a las preguntas de los jóvenes acerca de Jesús y de la Iglesia.

3) voy a empezar a reunirse con aquellos que sirven como ministros litúrgicos (lectores, ministros de la comunión santa, monaguillos). Estas reuniones no sólo nos dará la oportunidad de ir sobre los aspectos prácticos de servir en su ministerio, sino también para dar la oportunidad para que uno crezca en el conocimiento de su fe, especialmente en lo que respecta a su papel durante la misa.

Estas tres iniciativas son muy valiosos porque no son clases que se imparten, sino, más bien, una discusión y la conversación para los que se reunieron para encontrarse con Jesús y sus enseñanzas como la que han vivido en la Iglesia. 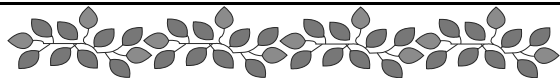
