PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

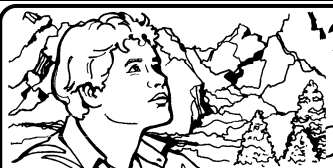

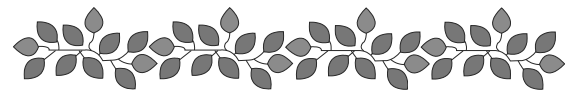
