Why Should I Register?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. Membership requires signing up and formally enrolling yourself in the parish. But it is also more than just filling out some forms. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of a parish.

Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a parish, what benefits and obligations the community has to the Diocese, and how many Masses and programs are planned and scheduled.

Registration not only shows you belong, but may be necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, participating in religious education programs and getting donation statements for tax purposes. At times young adults who have moved away for years think they are still registered under their parents. Or sometimes previously registered parishioners join another parish, or are inactive for a long period of time, but assume they are still registered here. When they want to come back to receive a sacrament, such as baptism or marriage, or perhaps enroll a child in the religious education program, they find that they are no longer registered here and must begin the process over.

Committing to a parish is much like a commitment to a family, sports team, school or community organization. Just like you want the parish to be there to provide Masses, Sacraments, education programs and ministries, the parish needs to be able to count on you to help and assist in their mission; to be an active member.

Are you registered with us? One way to know is if you receive regular communications from us, such as offertory envelopes or letters. If you do not receive at least one of these, then perhaps you are not registered here, you may want to check with the parish office staff.

Registering in the parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of our parish. As parish members, we are all here to help each other on our spiritual journey; we don't want to do this alone. As much as you need us, we need you, too. I am asking all regular parishioners to be registered.

Remember, children must attend classes for **TWO** consecutive years in order to receive a sacrament.

Please attend with your child. There is a meeting in the Gym immediately following Mass. At this time your child will sign a Letter of Intent regarding Confirmation, Each parent will fill out an Information Form. A packet regarding Confirmation requirements will be given to those in attendance.

Religious Education Program

Dear Parishioners,

We are very blessed that our Religious Education Program continues to grow. However, along with that blessing, we have to struggle to find teachers to meet the needs of all our children. We hope that if you are a parent of one of our students, a grandparent, a retiree, or someone who would like to help pass on our faith, that you will consider being a catechist.

There are not many requirements. First and foremost, you must be a practicing Catholic. All catechists must take a VIRTUS course, sign a Code of Conduct, and be willing to submit to a Background check. It is also required that catechists receive 10 hours of Living and Leading by Faith credits. These courses are often free, and there are some offered online for a nominal fee. These courses help deepen the understanding of our faith.

Our year runs from September until May. We meet with the children on Sunday mornings from 9:15AM until 10:45AM. If you do not feel that you can commit to a full year, perhaps you would consider being a substitute teacher. The requirements are the same, but Living and Leading by Faith credits are not mandatory.

If you are interested or would like more information, please call me at the Rectory. I am available Monday and Tuesday mornings from 9AM until 12:30PM. At any other times, please leave a message.

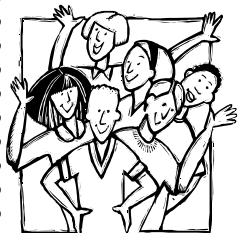

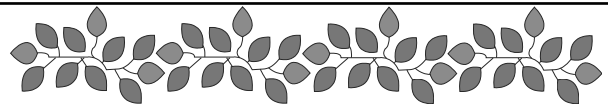

Please keep our RCIA members in your prayers as they prepare for the next step in their faith journey--the Rite of Election on the First Sunday of Lent. The Rite of Sending will take place in our Parish at a Mass next Sunday. Our Catechumens will take part in the Diocesan Rite of Election later that day with the Bishop.

*Diocese of Brooklyn -
Lenten Regulations 2019*

Once again, the celebration of Christ's Passion and Resurrection draws near. In our preparation for Easter, the Church invites us to observe the penitential and grace-filled season of Lent which commences THIS WEEK - March 6, 2019 with the observance of Ash Wednesday. Lent is a time of renewal for the entire Catholic community. It is also a time of spiritual accompaniment as we assist the catechumens and candidates who will be welcomed into communion with the Church during the Easter Season.

In order to assist the faithful of the Diocese of Brooklyn to take full advantage of the Lenten season, our Diocesan Bishop, the Most Reverend Nicholas DiMarzio, wishes to draw our attention to the following:

Abstinence – All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting – All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.

Easter Duty – After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is filled at another time of the year. By special indult, in the United States, the time period for fulfilling this precept has been extended to include the period beginning the First Sunday of Lent (March 10, 2019) to the celebration of Pentecost (June 9, 2019).

Reconciliation Monday – Our diocese will once again celebrate Reconciliation Monday on April 15, 2019, which is the Monday of Holy Week. As in recent years, this initiative provides generous opportunity for the faithful to experience God's mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. After having reached the age of discretion, members of the faithful are bound to confess once a year grave sins which have not already been absolved.
